FORT MEADE CITY COMMISSION**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Fort Meade will hold a Special Municipal Election on April 2, 2019 between the hours of 7 AM and 7 PM, for the election of one commissioner.

Seat Five – At Large

Petitions from Candidates will be accepted by the Deputy City Clerk beginning at Noon, Monday, February 11, 2019 until Noon, Thursday, February 14, 2019. Term of office is for the remainder of a four-year term. Present term expires January 11, 2022. Each Candidate for City Commissioner must be a qualified elector of the City of Fort Meade and shall have been a resident of the City for three years.

Candidates for Seat Five, At Large – must reside within the city limits of Fort Meade.

Petitions for Candidates for City Commissioner must bear the names of at least 25 persons qualified to vote in the City Election. Any Voter residing within the city limits of Fort Meade may sign only one petition for a Candidate for the At Large Seat.

You must be registered in the Polk County Registration Books in order to be entitled to vote. Registration Books will close on March 4, 2019, 29 days prior to the election. To vote in this City Election, you must reside within the city limits of Fort Meade.

All Precincts will vote in the Fort Meade Community Center at 10 SW Third Street.

Should a run-off election be required, it will be held April 16, 2019 at the Fort Meade Community Center.
