

**RESOLUTION R20-08**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FORT MEADE, FLORIDA; ACCEPTING A NEW MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT FOR A MULTI USE TRAIL ON EDGEWOOD DRIVE WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission for the City of Fort Meade, Florida has agreed to enter into a Maintenance Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation; and;

**WHEREAS**, the scope of the project consists of the construction of a 10-foot wide multi use path at Edgewood Drive North from US 98 to 9<sup>th</sup> Street NE;

**WHEREAS**, it is agreed that upon completion of the project, the City of Fort Meade shall be responsible, at its costs, for maintenance of said project, except for a Bus Shelter that may be constructed in the future along City right-of-way adjacent to an existing Bus Stop for Citrus Connection Route 25; and

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution will serve to acknowledge the City's participation in this new maintenance agreement of off system post-project transportation enhancements for a 10-foot wide multi use path.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT MEADE, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** The City of Fort Meade City Commission does hereby adopt, approve, and authorize execution of the TRANSPORTATION OFF SYSTEM POST PROJECT MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND CITY OF FORT MEADE (POST-PROJECT MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT #440356-1-52-01)

**SECTION 2.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the governing board of the City Commission of the City of Fort Meade.


