

RESOLUTION R-20-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FORT MEADE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP) UNDER ITS FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2021-22 FLORIDA RECREATION DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (FRDAP) FOR PHASE II OUTDOOR RECREATION IMPROVEMENTS AT THE FORT MEADE MARCELLA A. NELSON COMMUNITY CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$200,000.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) has an open cycle under its Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program (FRDAP);

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Program is to provide for Phase II Outdoor Recreation Improvements at the Fort Meade Marcella A. Nelson Community Center;

WHEREAS, the City has identified three (3) primary elements and one (1) support element to request in the grant application;

WHEREAS, outdoor amenities contemplated under this application include a new Splash Pad, a renovation of the Playground, a new Picnic Pavilion, and a new Restroom to support the Splash Pad;

WHEREAS, the project budget is estimated at \$200,000;

WHEREAS, the City plans to submit the application utilizing its REDI Match Waiver for a total project budget of \$200,000;

WHEREAS, the project will provide enhanced primary and support outdoor recreation amenities;


WHEREAS, the grant must be submitted on or before October 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, to submit a grant application, a Resolution of the City Commission must be adopted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Fort Meade, Florida that the City hereby approves the submittal of a Grant Application to the FDEP under its FRDAP to fund outdoor recreation improvements in the Development Category for Phase II Improvements totaling \$200,000 at the Fort Meade Marcella A. Nelson Community Center and that the Mayor is authorized to sign applications, assurances and certifications on behalf of the City.




